COMMUNITY REOPENING UPDATE

Residential Living:

Amenity Areas: are open in limited capacities in accordance with local regulations and oversight.

- Campus access – Everyone entering our campus will be screened according to CDC guidelines at campus gate guard station. These individuals with COVID symptoms or exposure to COVID positive individuals will be denied access. Facemasks and social distancing are required while in public areas.
- Dining – Ongoing apartment delivery services, pick-up available from main dining room and Bistro. Main dining room open by reservation in limited capacity (currently maximum of 25%) with social distancing.
- Fitness – Indoor gym by appointment only, currently limited by space to 1 individual or household. Outdoor gym equipment available by reservation or walk-up use if available.
- Pool – Open in limited capacity by reservation on sign up sheet located outside of pool in Oasis snack shack area.
- Activities – Open in limited capacity based on space. All activities outside of pool currently require mask wearing and social distancing.
- Chapel Services – Continuing intercampus broadcasting of Chapel Services. In person Chapel attendance to resume in limited capacity (maximum of 25%) on April 11. Attendance requires mask wearing and social distancing.

Assisted Living:

Amenity Areas:

- Dining – Open in limited capacity with social distancing.
- Activities – Open in limited capacity. Requires mask wearing and social distancing.
- Visitation - Assisted Living is open for indoor and outdoor visits. The outdoor visiting area is located on the patio outside of the main activity room. Indoor visits are limited to one person per resident. To schedule, they can use the website clmm.setmore.com or call Janette at 610-931-1180. Screening upon arrival and wearing a face mask is required.

Skilled Nursing Care:

Amenity Areas:

- Dining – Open in limited capacity with social distancing.
- Activities – Open in limited capacity. Requires mask wearing and social distancing.
- Visitation - Beginning, Monday, March 29th, 2021 we have begun offering reservations for indoor visitation on our website that is also used for window visitation and outdoor visits. The reservations will start at 9am and continue until 5pm every day of the week. If these times do not work with your schedules I ask that you reach out to our Activity Coordinator, Richard Charfauros, to make other arrangements. For now, in order to accommodate everyone, we will be allowing 2 visitors at a time per Resident and the visit can last 30 minutes. We will only be allowing 5 Residents to have visitors at any one time. If you have special circumstances or need certain accommodations, please reach out to Rich as well. It is very important that these visits are scheduled prior to arriving and preferably the day before you will be visiting because we will need to consider our Resident's roommate and make other arrangements for them during your visit. You will be screened prior to entering the facility and we ask that you always wear a face covering and stay 6ft or more apart from one another. If you have COVID-19 symptoms or have been in close contact with a confirmed positive case, we ask that you reschedule your visit. If the Resident is in quarantine (yellow zone), you will need to wear full personal protective equipment (PPE) that we will provide as well as education on how to put on and take off PPE appropriately. This will include a gown, gloves, face shield and an N95 mask. As you will see on the CDPH spreadsheet, the Residents and the visitor's vaccination status will need to be accounted for. In order to have any amount of physical contact (i.e. Hand holding, hug, kiss) we will need to see verification of the visitors vaccination status and if both the Resident and the visitors are considered fully vaccinated (i.e., ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine) we will be able to allow brief, limited physical contact such as a small hug, hand holding etc.
